

Sub: Review of performance under IAY and PMAY(G).

It is to inform you that the performance for the year 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16 under IAY was not satisfactory. The State has a vision to achieve "Housing for All" much earlier than 2020. As per SECC data, 1.56 lakh families are being targeted in the State. The old sanctioned cases have to be made payment as per earlier guidelines immediately. Besides, the new cases are to be processed under PMAY. The status of the pending list is attached herewith at Annexure 'A'. Following action are to be taken immediately:-

1. The pending installments under IAY for the previous year are to be given as per the guidelines and norms of the IAY. The backlog of 2nd and 3rd installments should be cleared by 30th June, 2016.
2. A regular exhaustive monitoring is required to be done by the ADCs through BDPOs. The ADCs should analyze daily basis status on the Online MIS of IAY.
3. Further, the list of automatically included and deprived households which have kutchha walls and kutchha roof etc. as extracted from the SECC-2011 data, provided by the Ministry of Rural Development, was sent to you for circulating in the Gram Sabhas for ranking the prioritizing and then verify the beneficiaries for Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana(Gramin).
4. The status of category-wise finalized is to be uploaded after verification as approved procedures circulated vide memo. No. PMAY-2016/Spl.I, dated 08.04.2016. The prepared category wise draft lists for General, SC and Minorities and approved by Gram Sabhas are also to be monitored on weekly basis.
5. The concerned ADCs should review the progress of the above said information on daily basis and send the weekly report to State Headquarters as per the enclosed formats on each Friday positively to the Director, Rural Development to review the progress under IAY as well as PMAY(G) regularly.
6. The explanation will be sought from the concerned delinquent officers if instructions are not complied with or performance is not found satisfactory.
