The Terms of Reference will be as follows :—

- (i) The Committee would monitor the flow of funds at various channels, including allocations, releases, utilization and unspent balances.
- (ii) The Committee should ensure that the scheme is implemented as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation and no addition or alteration is done.
- (iii) The Committee would look into complaints received by it, in respect of the implementation of the Programmes, including complaints of misappropriation/diversion of funds of the scheme of the Ministry and recommend follow-up actions.

- (iv) The Committee would consider all Evaluation Reports, Area Officers' Reports and such other Reports sent to it by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation and would cause to take necessary follow up action and corrective measures wherever required.

The Headquarters of this Committee will be at Chandigarh.

The Committee will hold its meetings atleast once in a year.

The TA/DA, if any, will be born by the respective Departments.
